This literacy resource focuses on positional language which can pose some difficulties for younger pupils and SEN pupils.

This pack includes five worksheets based on vegetables for pupils to practise these essential skills. The worksheets include language like first, last, third, before, beside, between, after, under, above.

If the pupils are able, they can read the instructions independently and follow the directions. Alternatively, the teacher can read the directions aloud and pupils follow the directions accordingly.

The pupil should then write the letters in order on the line at the bottom of the page to discover what “vegetable” word they have found.
