

Garden Centre Colouring


The Garden Centre vocabulary should be taught in advance of this exercise. This exercise would then serve as a useful assessment tool.

- 1. Colour the garden fork red.
- 2. Colour the large flower purple and pink.
- 3. Colour the seed brown.
- 4. Colour the plant pot blue.
- 5. Colour the rake green.
- 6. Colour the three flowers in three different colours


