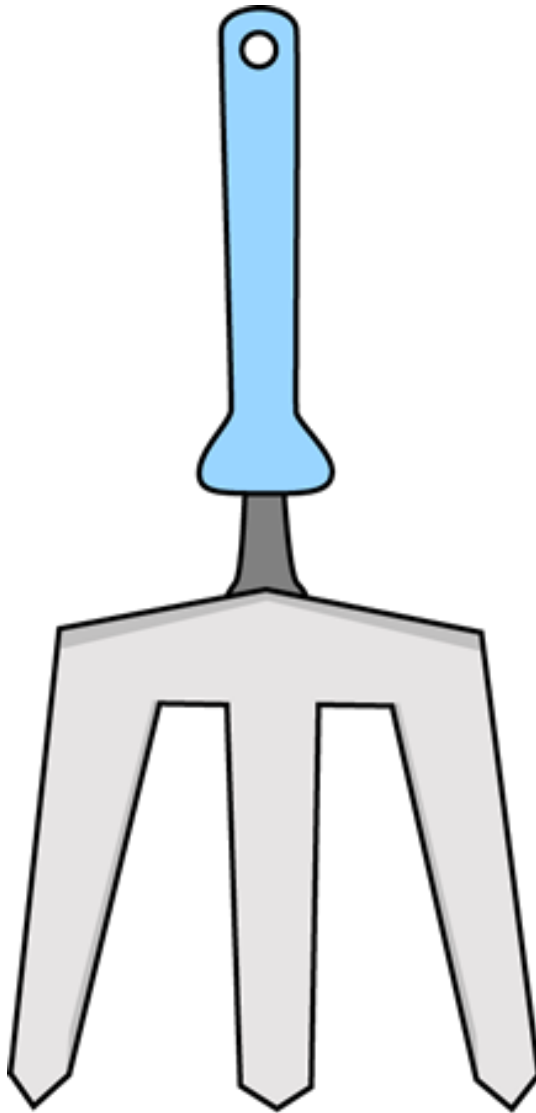
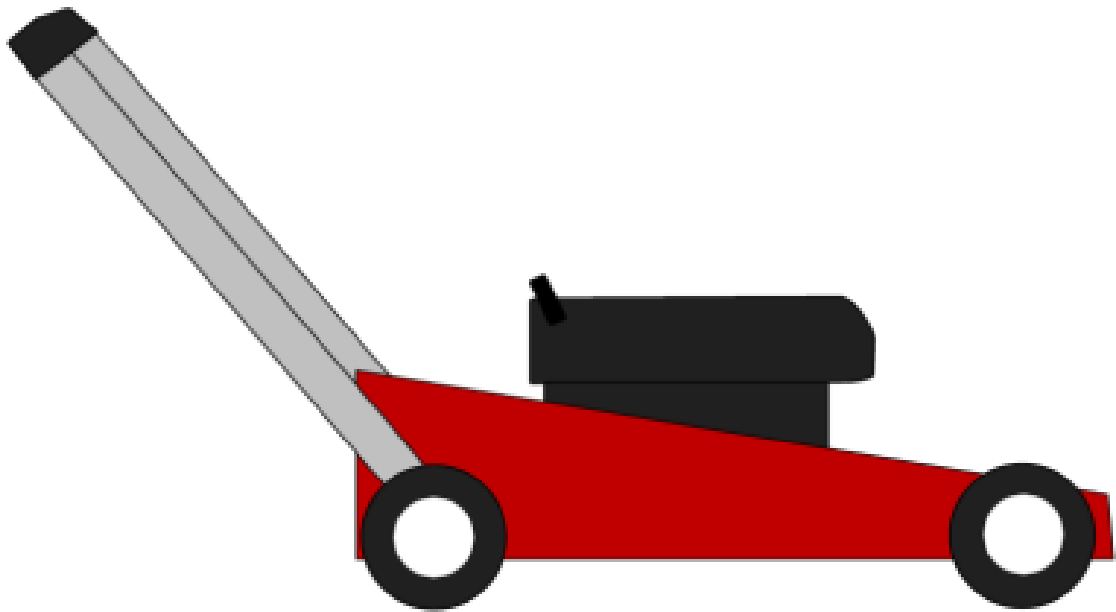
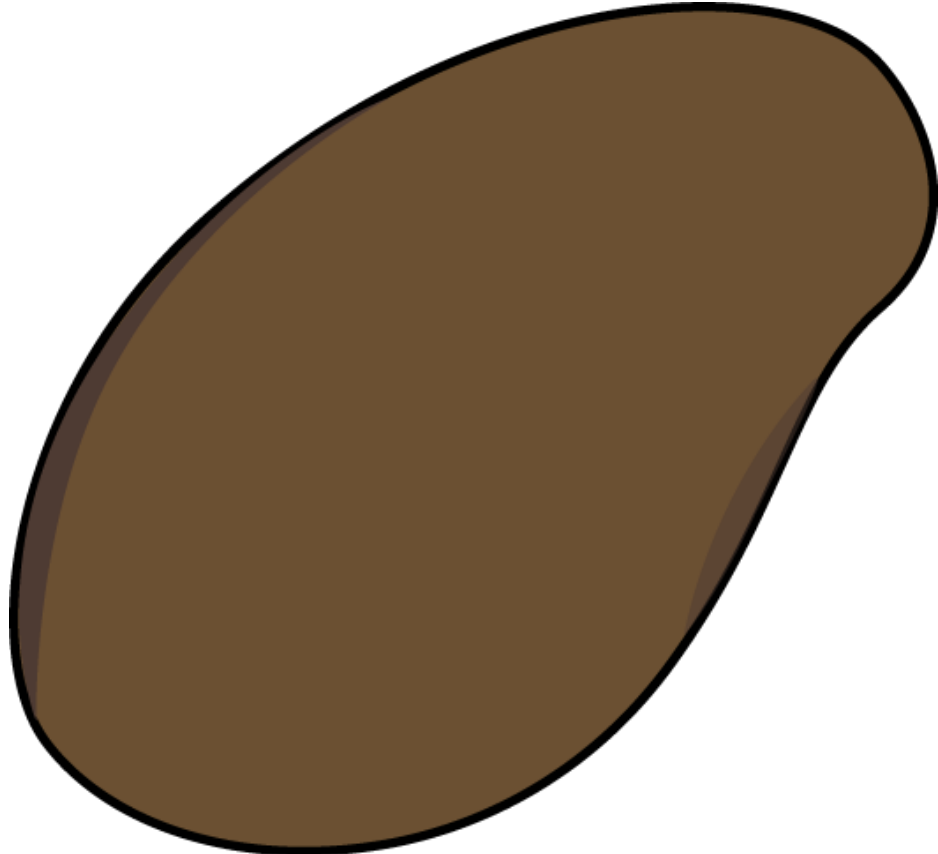
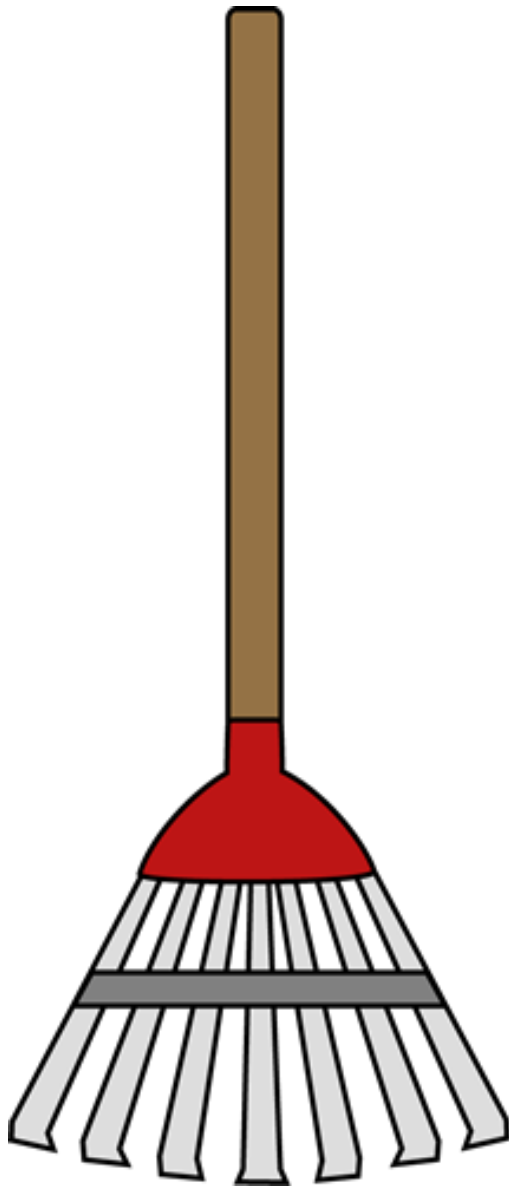


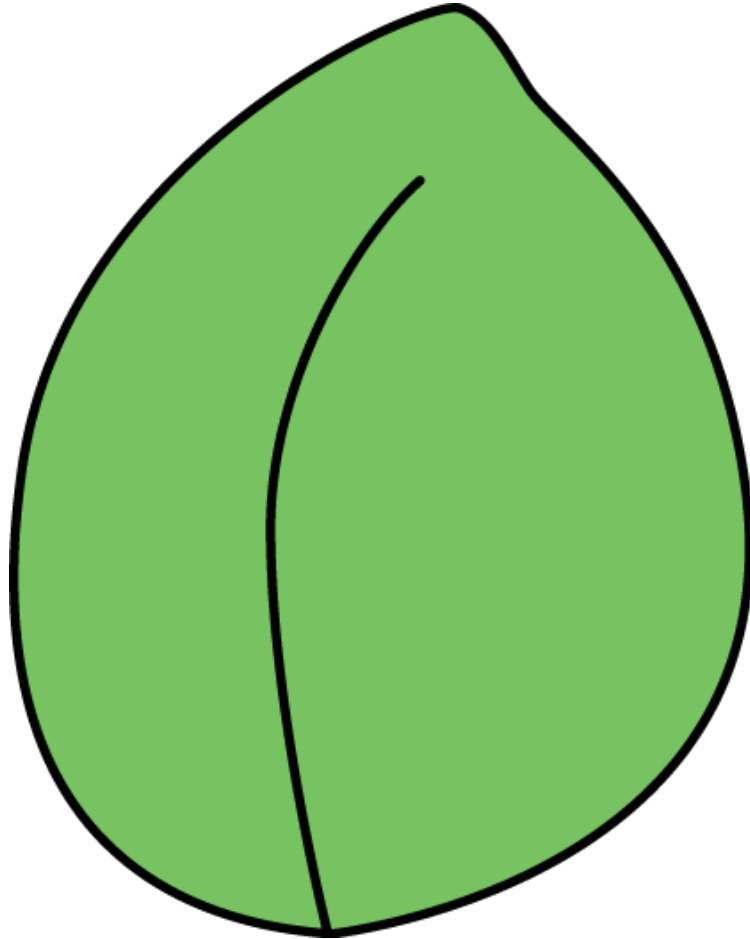
The Gardening Book

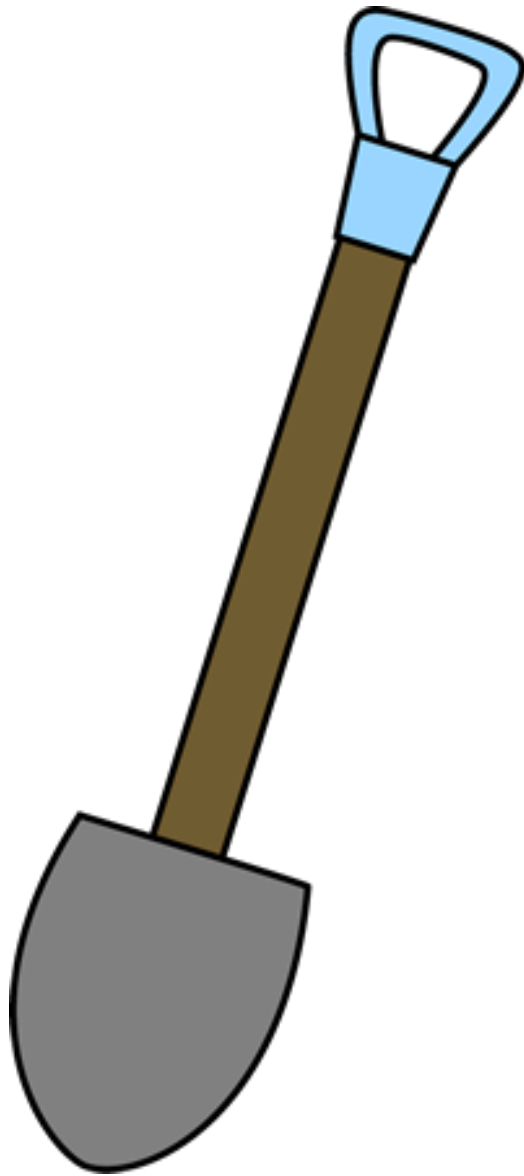


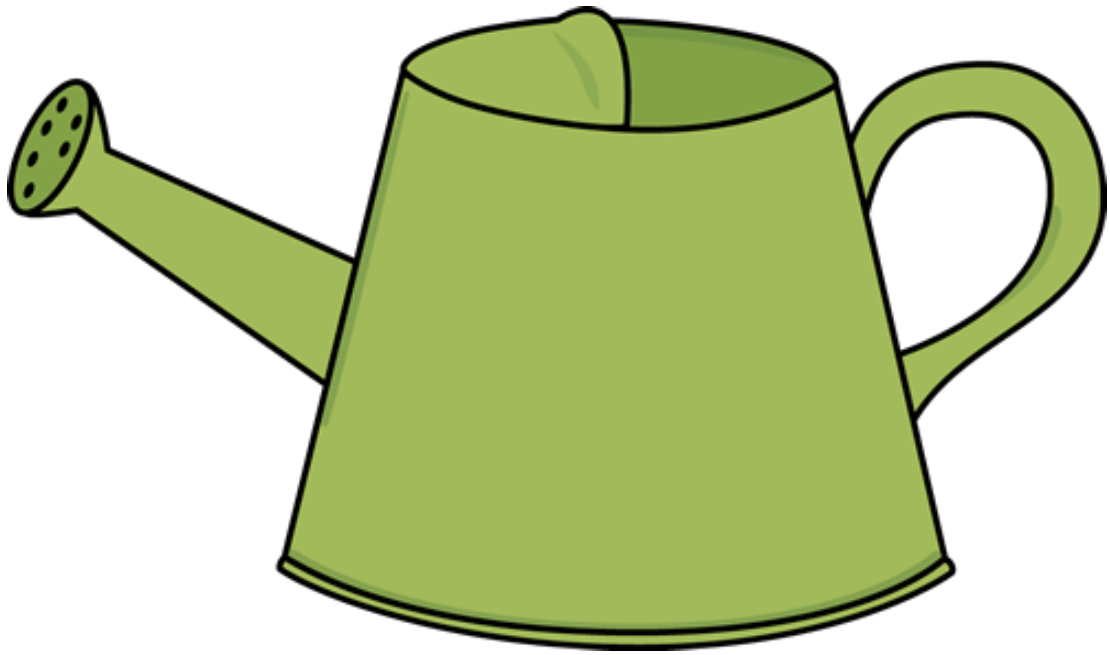


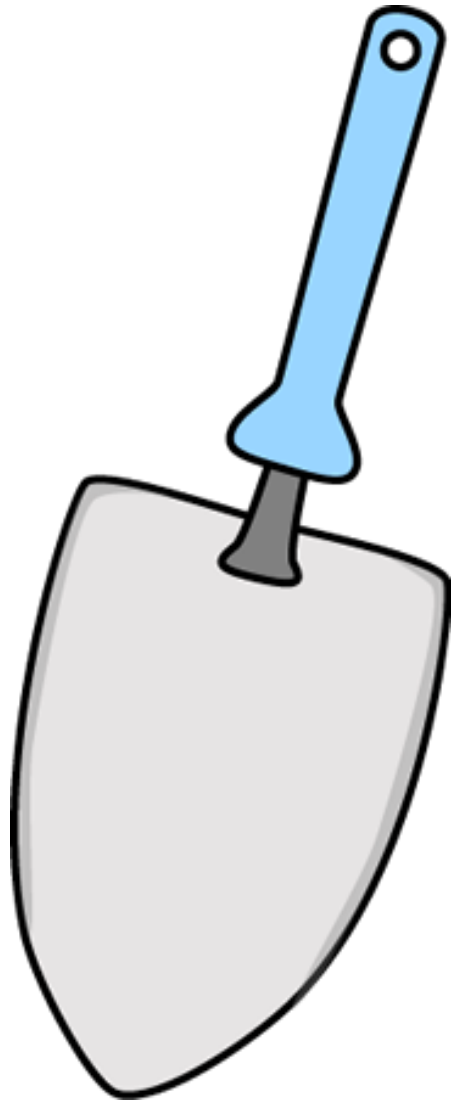


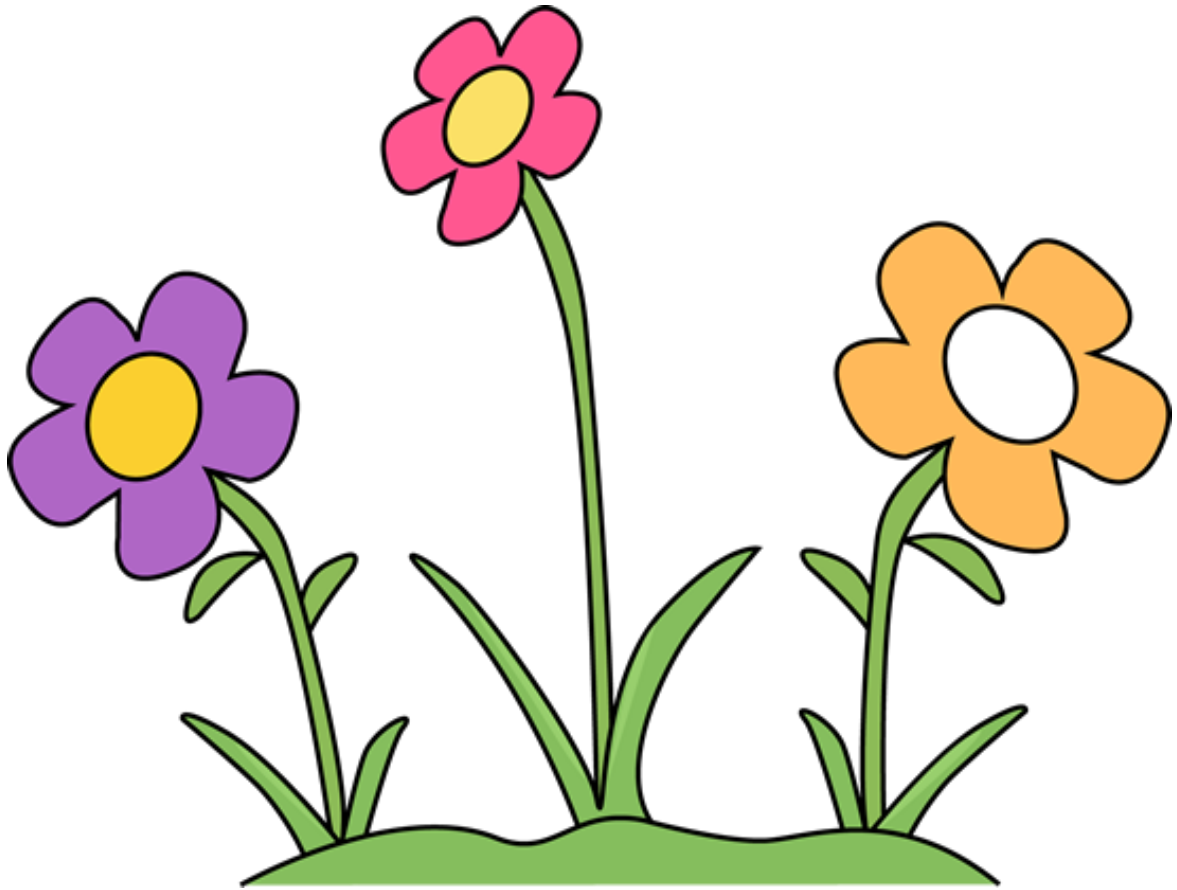


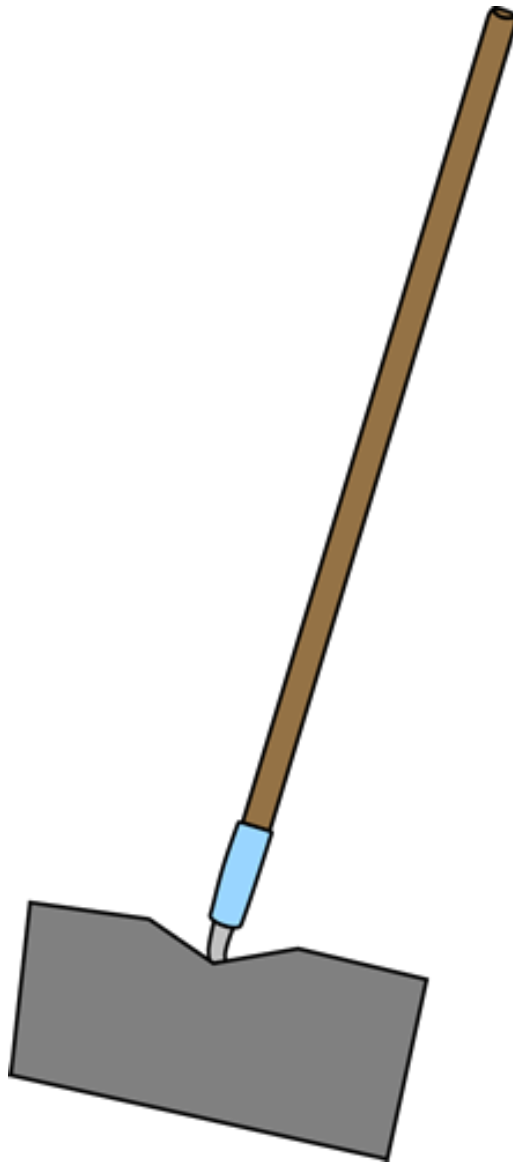












The gardening fork has a blue handle.

This literacy resource book with a gardening theme is aimed at the development of pupils' reading comprehension. It is made up of ten pages, each page containing a strong image and a sentence placeholder. The ten sentences that go with each page are at the end of the pack.

It is suggested that you laminate all of the pages in the resource. Cut out the ten sentences at the end of the pack. Bind the book pages together. Place Velcro in the sentence placeholders and on the rear of each of the sentences.

The pupil then has to look at each page in the book and read the sentences in order to find which one best describes what is happening in the picture.

Alternatively, the book could simply be stapled together and the pupil could cut and paste the sentences onto the correct page.
