Some countries decided that they did not want to take sides in the war so they remained neutral. They included:

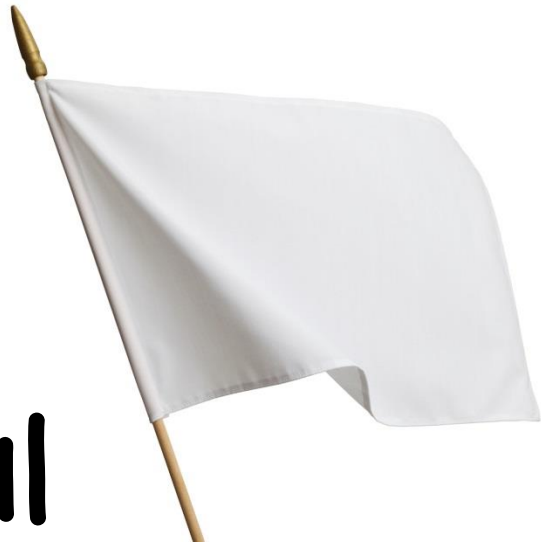
