Alliteration is when a sentence or a phrase has many words that start with the same sound.

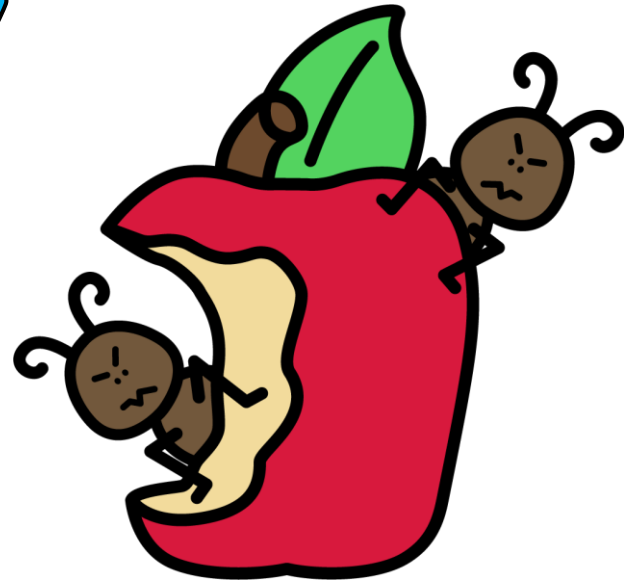
Alliteration appeals to the listener's ear as the repeated sounds draws attention to the text.

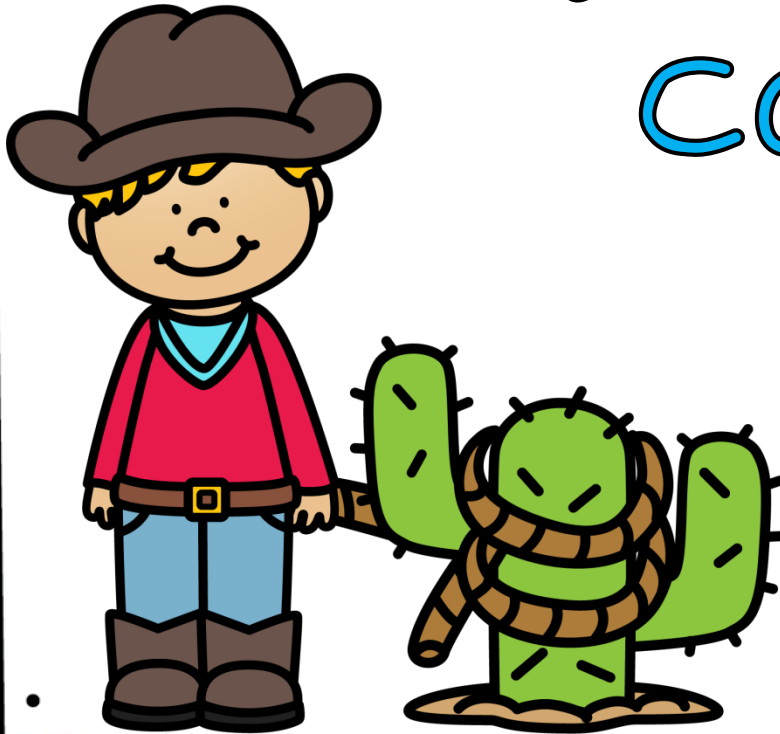

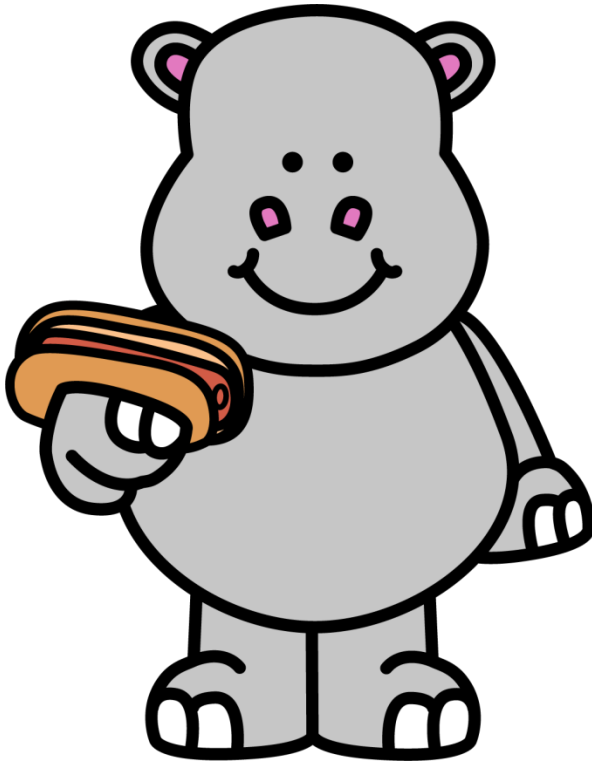

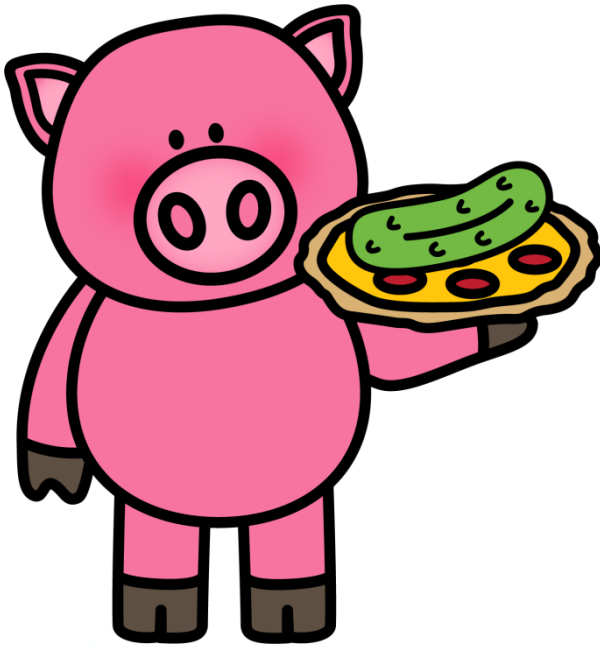
