#### **Speech Bubbles**

Use these speech bubbles for pupils to react to the story at any given point. Get them to think about what might be going through the mind of the character at that particular point in the story.

There is a lined and a blank speech bubble for each of the characters. If you want the pupils to write a paragraph, use the lined speech bubble. If you want them to write something shorter – for example, some exclamations – use the blank speech bubble.

I've included a variety of headers for display purposes in the classroom, depending on whichever character's thoughts the pupils are writing about.
