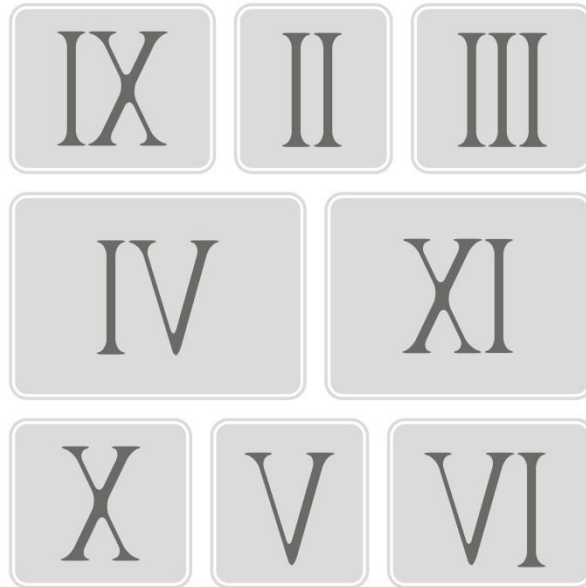

# Roman Numerals

## Rule 1:



**A letter  
can only be  
repeated  
three  
times.**

# Roman Numerals

## Rule 2:

**A letter  
repeats its  
value that  
many  
times.**





# Roman Numerals

## Rule 3:



**Numbers  
are written  
from left  
to right.**

# Roman Numerals

## Rule 4:



If a smaller number comes before a larger number, the smaller number is taken away from the larger.



# Roman Numerals

## Rule 5:

**A bar placed  
above a  
Roman  
Numeral  
means it is  
multiplied by  
1,000.**



# Roman Numerals

## Rule 6:



The symbols used are I(1), V(5), X(10), L(50), C(100), D(500), M(1000).



# Roman Numerals

## Rule 7:



If one or more letters are placed after another letter of greater value, add that amount.

# Roman Numerals

## Rule 8:

**Only subtract  
powers of ten  
(I, X, or C,  
but not V or  
L).**





# Roman Numerals

## Rule 9:

Only  
subtract one  
number  
from  
another.



# Roman Numerals

## Rule 10:

**Do not  
subtract a  
number from  
one that is  
more than 10  
times greater.**
