Numbers are written from left to right.

Rule 4:



If a smaller number comes before a larger number, the smaller number is taken away from the larger.



Rule 5:

A bar placed above a Roman Numeral means it is multiplied by 1,000.






Rule 6:



The symbols used are I(1), V(5), X(10), L(50), C(100), D(500), M(1000).

Rule 7:




Rule 8:

Only subtract powers of ten (I, X, or C, but not V or L).





Rule 9:






Rule 10:
