This type of poem focuses on the visual. It also focuses on verbs. It follows a set pattern. Each verse has two lines. Line one is simply "Look". The second line begins with "Can you see" and ends with a verb ending in "ing".

Think of a situation and describe the images that you see in that environment in a "Look" poem eg. the beach, the farm, the airport etc.
