A loud

When Reading Aloud, aim for:

Fluency



This means that your reading should flow easily and with as little hesitation as possible.

When Reading Aloud, aim for:

Clarity



This means that your voice should be as clear as possible so that the listeners can understand what you are saying.

When Reading Aloud, aim for:

Expression



This means that you are reading with meaning and putting expression into your voice. You must remember that when you are reading, you are telling a story.

When Reading Aloud, aim to be:

Audible



This means that your voice is loud enough for your listeners to be able to hear you.
