**A carpet of bluebells can be seen growing in the forest.**



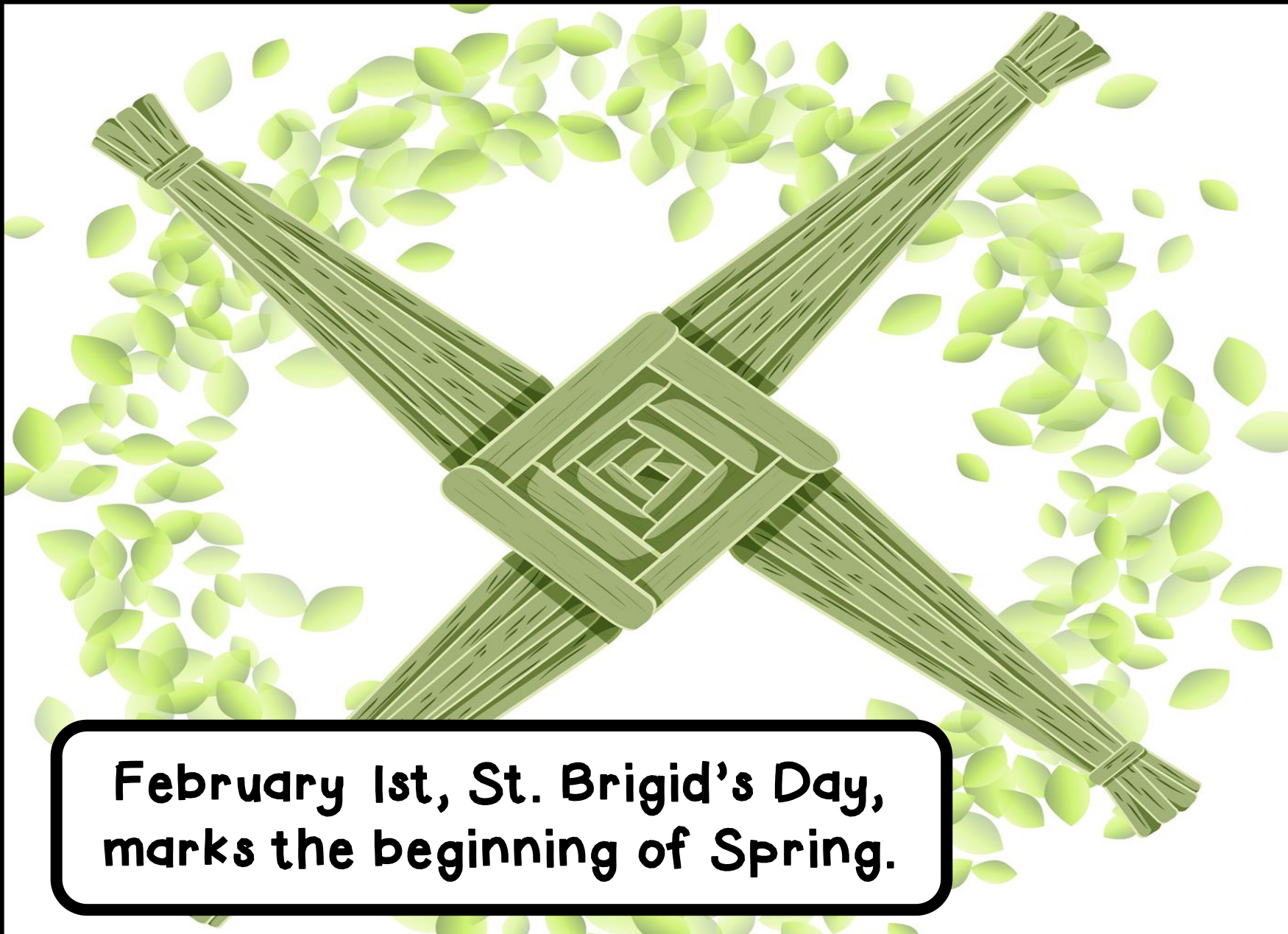


**The smell of the first cut
