



flip flops bikini dress sun glasses hat shorts
















swim sun shorts glasses suit shirt dress hat








dress shorts top flip flops sun glasses hat







## How to Play

- I. Divide your class up into teams -I have allowed for up to six teams. Place a laminated baseboard on the ground in front of each team.
- 2. Place six cones around your space (hall, yard or pitch). Depending on age group, place the cones at varying distances from the teams.
- 3. Place one of each small laminated coloured picture/shadow/word under each cone eg one yellow/red/black/blue/green/purple goes under each of the six cones.
- 4. The player at the top of each group has to run to a cone, take a picture/shadow/word with the same colour border that matches the coloured borders on the team base board, replace the cone and run back to their team with that picture/shadow/word. Each player takes a turn to run to a cone to get a picture/shadow/word for their team.
- 5. When all six cards have been collected, the team must match them to the images on their base board.
- 6. The first team to correctly match the six cards is the winner.

## How to Play

- 7. It's important for the rest of the team who are not running to pay attention to which cones have been visited by other members of their team, so as not to waste time running to the same cone.
- 8. If a player returns to their team with a card whose coloured border does not match the coloured borders on their team baseboard, that player has to return that card to its cone and collect another from a different cone.
- 9. A player may only collect one card at a time.
- 10. You could also have decoy cones with no cards underneath them.
- II. To make the game harder, you could move the cones further away.
- 12. The resource allows for three rounds of this game matching picture to picture; shadow to picture; word to picture.
- 13. To see if pupils are paying attention, you could give them a different colour base board for each round of the game.
- 14. This game involves teamwork, strategy and problem solving and hopefully the pupils will enjoy it.







