
BLOW PAINTING

- I. This is a really easy lesson to do, yet it is one which the children will really enjoy.
- 2. A4 paper is probably big enough for this lesson. Try to use a heavier art paper rather than photocopier paper which doesn't hold watery paint very well.
- 3. Pour some poster paints into plastic cups or jars and thin down using water.
- 4. Using old teaspoons, pour drops of different colour paints all over the page.
- 5. Using recyclable drinking straws, blow the watery paints in all different directions over the page. Allow the different colour paints to overlap, giving new colours as the paints mix.
- 6. When all the paint has been "blown" all over the page, allow the painting to dry.
- 7. Display the finished paintings all together to form a great abstract painting display.
