## LOLLIPOP SEASCAPE

This is a nice visual arts lesson to do during the summer term. It can be done as a standalone art lesson, or it can be done as part of a "Sea" theme in the classroom.

- I. This picture could be completed on a sheet of blue sugar paper to act as the sea background.
- 2. Alternatively, you could paint a blue background on a sheet of art paper using a brush or sponge. Try to get the effect of having a darker blue near the bottom for the sea and a lighter blue near the top for the sky. This can be done simply by spreading the paint a little thinner near the top. You could also use some white paint to mix a lighter shade of blue for a sky area of the page.
- 3. To create the boating scene, glue two lollipop sticks for the bottom of the boats in two different areas of the page.
- 4. Glue a vertical lollipop as the mast for each boat.
- 5. Glue triangles of coloured paper for the sails.
- 6. Glue blue paper, which has been cut into wave shapes, onto the bottom of the picture.
- 7. Glue a yellow/orange circle in one corner of the page for the sun.
- 8. Glue full and half lollipop sticks as the rays of the sun.
- 9. Allow to dry overnight before displaying on a display board.
